- * Awards will be open to Graduate Students and Postdocs.

- * Postdoc applicants will be evaluated separately from Graduate Students.
- * Awards will be in the range of \$US600-\$US1200 (approximately). The precise number and value of each award is at the discretion of the committee.
- * Awardees must give a contributed presentation (poster or talk) during ISEP XVIII.
- * Awards are conditional on the trainee being a member of **both** ISEP and ISoP: You do **not** have to be a member of either society to apply. However, if you are offered an award you **will** have to join both societies in order to **accept** the award.
- * The deadline for applications is **April 1, 2010**. Successful applicants will be notified approximately April 15.
